Approach

Temora Shire Council commissioned a MARKYT[®] Community Scorecard to:

- Support a review of the Community Strategic Plan, Delivery Plan and Operational Plan
- Assess overall perceptions of Temora Shire as a place to live, work and visit
- Determine community aspirations and priorities
- Assess performance levels and service area gaps
- Benchmark performance against other councils





Approach

Temora Shire Council (TSC) commissioned CATALYSE® to conduct an independent MARKYT® Community Scorecard.

All community members were invited to take part. Scorecard invitations were sent to all households and residential PO Boxes in the Temora Shire region using Australia Post's unaddressed mail services. Respondents could complete the scorecard in hard copy or online.

CATALYSE[®] sent email invitations to TSC's customer contacts, and TSC provided supporting promotions through various communication channels. The scorecard was open from 23 September to 11 October 2024.








The scorecard was completed by 703 community members with various connections to TSC:















Community driven actions

Community Voices

"Better facilities so we don't have to travel to Wagga Wagga."

"Health services. Waiting 5 weeks for a non-urgent consult is ridiculous. As older citizens this is life threatening and demoralising.

"Poor access to health services such as getting in to see a GP with bookings weeks' wait in advance - up to 2 months at times. Also limited local mental health services such as counselling or psychiatry professionals. No service available for skin cancer checks needing to travel to Wagga or further."

"Health and Community is an ongoing issue - with an aged population there needs to be support for people to remain in their homes for as long as practicable."

"Free housing to encourage more doctors and health services staff. More ambulances and paramedics stationed in Temora. More support and home visit staff."

"We still need more doctors. We need to advocate for this with our state and federal members. There should be incentives for doctors to work in regional areas. We need to change some lifestyle aspects to make living in Temora more attractive to people from metropolitan backgrounds (restaurants, shops open Sundays, more entertainment)."

"Bring more doctors to the area including providing opportunities for their partners and children to encourage them to stay."

"Help / Speed up new hospital. Encourage new doctors to the area."

"Hospital upgrade. With all the new housing blocks selling this is a big consideration, to have bed numbers and facilities up to standard."

"I know the new hospital is a priority for council but to optimise this fully we need to make sure we have housing accessible for support staff like nurses, cleaners etc. I would like to see Council plan how they intend to draw staff to make a home in our town where they can find access to housing etc."



- Advocate for timely completion of the Temora Hospital redevelopment project and improved access to general, specialist and allied health services to reduce wait times and the need to travel to Wagga Wagga and beyond to access health care.
- Develop strategies and incentives, such as free or subsidised accommodation, to attract doctors and other healthcare workers to settle in Temora with their families.
- Advocate for better access to aged care facilities and home support services.

Community Action Plan Services, facilities and care for seniors

Community driven actions

Community Voices

"Continue to campaign for aged care expansion / improvement / redevelopment to cater for aging population."

"Needs a new, updated aged care facility to replace the very outdated Greenstone Lodge in an ageing population."

"Update Greenstone Lodge, building assisted living facilities. Where people can live in community and not become isolated. They will get the help they need but do not need intensive care like Narraburra or Greenstone."

"We need something like 'Settlers Village', where older members can access help if needed, or be more independent but are living a community lifestyle."

"Temora has a significant population of older people and to maintain people living in the shire in their own homes we need to make sure we have the services to cater for this."

"Council to encourage more development of senior housing and associated care. More help for seniors to stay in their own homes, including some form of transport (Area I)."

"Public transport needs to be available daily for people to access day to day needs."

"More footpaths for ease of getting around, and with the loss of the taxi service this inhibits some of the elderly."

"Temora has a growing number of aged senior residents using electric gophers and need safer footpaths for safety reasons and good access into their shopping destinations. Provide all future footpaths on even grades, that is - avoid dips and side dips at each resident's driveway. The side dip is a scary problem to senior gopher riders."

"Facilities for seniors. There are no facilities. No places to gather except ex services or a café."

"Seniors need a permanent place to gather, for male and females to socialise and feel relaxed to be in. A place to chatter to friends, meet and do things that interest them and feel comfortable in, whether it's for a cup of coffee or a day long activity."



- Advocate for more aged care services and facilities to cater for Temora's ageing population. Suggestions include:
 - Upgrade or replace Greenstone Lodge
 - More retirement villages and assisted living facilities
 - o More in-home support services
 - o Better access to health care.
 - Better access to transport services to access essential services.
- Upgrade footpaths to ensure they are even and safe for elderly pedestrians, gophers and mobility aids.
- Consider providing a seniors centre.

Community Action Plan Local roads (including bridges)

Community driven actions

Community Voices

"There needs to be more emphasis placed on road maintenance & upgrading. Good roads attract more growth in terms of farming, business & tourism & also make for a better place to live."

"Our local roads are a disgrace. They are all uneven. It's not just the potholes. The road surfaces need ripping up and levelling and resealing."

> "Better maintenance of roads including dirt road grading regularly. And quicker completion on roadworks."

"By paying attention to the rough edges of the roads. More grading needed. Clean the long grass away from the drains."

"Road shoulders & verges - better maintenance to prevent edge drop offs, edge decay of the seal, improved drainage away from the road formation. Prevention rather than repair. More sealing of shoulders, even 450mm, combined with basic edge markings, would prolong pavement life & improve road safety."

> "We still have dirt roads that are being accessed by a lot of vehicles that are not maintained. With the amount of traffic that goes through, it should be paved."

"Relook at the policy on re sheeting gravel roads . Just doing patch-up jobs until policy says re sheeting can happen often costs more .. do it once and do it properly. Grade earlier at in preparation for harvest giving roads time to settle. Consult the locals that use the roads."

"A heavy vehicle bypass. Upgrade of rural roads to be able to safely move the size machinery now travelling on these roads. The roads are not keeping up with the size and types of vehicles using them and therefore they are becoming damaged and unsafe."

"Heavy vehicle bypass. Will be difficult to achieve and expensive but must be planned for and budgeted for by all relevant authorities and all levels of government."



- Maintain local roads to a high standard, in particular:
 - o repair potholes
 - o grade dirt roads regularly
 - o clear drains and seal and repair shoulders
 - seal dirt roads used by higher volumes of traffic and heavy machinery
 - ensure all repairs are a long-term solution, not a temporary fix
- Advocate for a heavy vehicle bypass to divert trucks away from the town centre.

Community Action Plan Community safety and crime prevention

Community driven actions

Community Voices

"More police during the night when crime is more likely to occur."

"More police activity. Have a police station that is manned daily / nightly - Number 1."

"More of a police presence at night, especially around known problematic areas."

"Community safety - crime prevention. There needs to be a more prevalent presence of policing. Temora has a drug problem and if it is known to me then it is definitely known to others.

"Establishing more security cameras on corner streets off the main street, eg. Victoria and Vesper Streets intersection and Baker St."

"There seems to be increasing crime and theft. More lighting and cameras."

"Lobby for improved crime prevention. Facebook is full of thievery in local area and street lighting doesn't promote safety."

"Provide guidance, support and encouragement to young adults who are aimless and have no aspirations; provide facilities and education to inspire self-confidence and ambitions, and hence a purpose in life and ability to pursue one's aspirations and ambitions. Leadership in this aspect is paramount. Council has the wherewithal to address this and take initiatives."

"There is an impression with young people that the authorities will not help them and ultimately, they will be targeted if they talk up. There is a lack of help/support between the law and young people that may bridge this gap."

"Advocacy for harsher penalties for crimes."

"Strongly advocate to the State Government to keep laws strong to maintain the standards we've gotten used to."



- Advocate greater police presence with more patrols, especially at night, to address local concerns, including drug use, vandalism and break-ins.
- Install more CCTV cameras and lighting in known hotspots.
- Address youth crime with community programs, support services and positive engagement with law enforcement.
- Lobby the state government for a strong stance on law enforcement.

Community Action Plan Services and facilities for families / children

Community driven actions

Community Voices

"More day care and family care options."

"So much depends on having access to good childcare services if you want to attract and retain staff for things like health services and economic development. Not having access to childcare means half your workforce is forced to stay at home looking after kids. This is especially difficult for health services that rely on a predominantly female workforce."

> "Help daycare centres find staff to enable more children to be in care for working parents."

"Family health / Community health. Early childhood community nurses -Lactation consultants, MGP-Midwifery."

"Support for young mums and children. Increase support and services through the excellent community centre."

"Services and facilities for families and children. More programs to help them out. More push to help parents' mental health."

"Improve playground equipment and parks in Ariah Park. It would be great to have play equipment that is appropriate for toddlers also."

"Need more activities available for younger kids/ toddlers like mini soccer etc. Something in town like a play maze/ indoor play area for babies/ smaller children."

"Toddler and kids' sports. Playgroups outside of working hours. Toddler activities. Swimming lessons outside of work hours."

"Quick, safe building / room for mothers and children and babies who come into Temora for shopping and appointments from smaller towns. Have some comfortable chairs for nursing mothers. Toys and books for children, microwave for heating food, bottles, etc., change table."

"Although the services are available for new families, eg. story time and baby bounce, the Temora Shire is lacking in facilities. There are no adequate change rooms for babies / toddlers for the public. (The library is NOT always open)."



- Advocate for additional child-care facilities to support working parents. Consider incentives to attract child-care providers and workers to Temora.
- Advocate for improved healthcare and support services for children and families, including child health nurses, lactation consultants, playgroups and support for new parents etc.
- Provide a range of activities for families with children, including improved playgrounds, toddler activities, indoor play areas, swimming lessons etc.
- Provide more public parent rooms with baby change facilities.

Community Action Plan Animal management (dogs and cats)

Community driven actions

Community Voices

- Deliver a more proactive and responsive ranger service to control stray dogs and cats.
- Increase ranger powers and enforce regulations relating to animal ownership including registration, desexing and strays.
- Provide community education about responsible animal ownership.
- Provide a greater variety of dog exercise areas enclosed, on/off leash etc.

- "Stricter control of cats and roaming dogs.."
- "More patrolling to ensure roaming cats and dogs are dealt with."
- "Better access to pest ranger to collect stray dogs and cats, especially after dark. Stray animals roam more at night."
- "Better management of strays and irresponsible owners. Enforcing registration of pets"
 - "More power to remove stray animals, harsher penalties to the offenders, and someone in council who will actually listen to the locals concern about stray animals and noisy animals."
 - "Animal management. The pound needs improvement and legally needs a cattery attached. The stray dog and cat issue needs to be addressed. Start fining people for straying and unregistered animals."
 - "Educating animal owners on their responsibilities. Better enforcement of rules and regulations. Too many dogs roaming the streets."
 - "Greater community education regarding responsible pet ownership and increased consequences for poor animal management by residents."
 - "Dog park safe, off lead area. Lake is too far out."
 - "Could we get some more dog parks? Even ones where they still have to be on a leash. There's only one and one small part of Lake Centenary."
 - "Dog friendly parks or dog runs put into parks."



Community Action Plan Waste management

Community driven actions

Community Voices

"Kerb-side recycling, yellow and green bins. It's ridiculous that our town does not have kerb-side recycling in 2024."

> "Really, for the price we are paying for our rates we deserve to have a recyclable waste collection."

"Waste management. Definitely need a 3 bin collection, like all other towns."

"Recycling. Would be nice to have 3 bins. 1. Household waste. 2. Garden waste. 3. Recycling. Temora seems to be behind in this area."

"Provide a proper recycling centre - with appropriate bins for residents use. The service would help to eliminate the amount of refuse going into landfill. And Temora would be seen as doing its part toward a greener environment."

"Waste management. Better planning of landfill usage, rather than the ad hoc system presently used. Recycling at tips and compacting of rubbish."

> "Look at expanding the tip area for recycling and green waste. Similar to other shire councils."

"Need to desperately catch up to other areas in complete waste recycling and kerb side pickups. Waste management facility needs to open at 10 am on Saturdays and Sundays."

"Something needs to be done urgently about recycling in Temora. It's getting too much for Lions, there needs to be a pickup option for those who can't get their reycling to the Lions depot, and something for those who cannot get their green waste to the tip, or who cannot pay a private business to collect it."



• Introduce kerbside recycling collection.

- Implement a 3-bin system with separate bins for general waste, recycling waste and green waste.
- Make recycling more accessible for residents

 provide more recycling stations, longer
 opening hours at the tip and separate areas
 for recycling and green waste at the tip.

Community Action Plan Economic development and job creation

Community driven actions

Community Voices

- Attract more businesses to the town to diversify the local economy beyond agriculture and create sustainable job opportunities. Consider marketing, financial assistance, incentives and grants.
- Encourage young people to stay in Temora by developing industries that can provide skilled, non-seasonal work, training and apprenticeships.
- Attract a wider range of shops and department stores.
- Provide better infrastructure to support local businesses, including public transport and reliable telecommunications services.

"Encourage new business outside the agriculture area to diversify business types and create employment and increase population."

"Encouragement and assistance to new business to Temora. Make Temora a real attractive destination for new business small and large."

"Although it is probably on the agenda I believe that more businesses should be encouraged, with incentives possibly, to start here and grow. It may, with a range of different businesses, create more jobs here."

"Grants to open new business ideas and promote / market grants to train staff."

"Economic development and job creation will help to keep our younger people working within the shire. Jobs for younger people, training and availability of then skilled people will attract more businesses to the shire."

"More apprenticeships. Invite major industries to open their business in town. Better utilise the airport for logistic activities, not just air shows."

"Bringing more shops of difference to town, so people can shop locally more."

"The town needs a hub - Kmart, Big W or Harris Scarfe. The population is growing with all the new subdivisions."

"Perhaps encourage another supermarket into the area. ALDI maybe. Perhaps encourage more fast food. KFC teenagers love the stuff! People leave town to purchase groceries and then spend on other products. Money that leaves the Shire."

"Help get more phone coverage in local area. Phone reception black spots."

"Need better public transport services in Ariah Park and Temora."



Community Action Plan Public and on-demand transport

Community driven actions

Community Voices

"Public transport has all but disappeared since the taxi business was lost. Effort should be made to gain such a service again."

"No taxis - what do the elderly do who cannot drive / have no family in Temora?"

"Taxi service for Temora / Community bus service for seniors and better lighting around the streets."

"Promote an Uber service. Local 'Taxi' service is not full time."

"A reliable taxi / transport service within Temora and public transport facilities to / from Wagga - Daily."

"Public transport options within our shire that could support travel for shopping, appointments or employment eg from outlying towns into Temora as well as to other towns like Cootamundra, West Wyalong or Wagga."

"Transport for those working in Wagga mainly, but also Coota. Alternative means of getting to work needed with petrol costs so high."

"Provide a bus service between Wagga and Temora that operates at least once per week and returns on the same day, at a reasonable price, whereby travellers have at least 3.5 hours in Wagga."

"Without a car / licence, Temora can be a very difficult place to get to or from anywhere. Perhaps a regular bus service to / from Wagga or Young would help those without a licence / transport to access services and shopping not available locally??"



- Deliver better transport options to assist nondrivers, particularly aged persons, with daily activities such as shopping and medical appointments. Suggestions include:
 - o a reliable, on-demand taxi service;
 - o a Council-run community bus service;
 - o a ride-share provider like Uber.
- Provide a more extensive bus network with more routes and more times connecting Temora to other towns including Wagga Wagga, Cootamundra and Sydney.






